The DHS manages an annual budget of nearly \$2.7 billion and a workforce of more than 2,230 employees. Our employees provide timely, efficient and effective programs, benefits and services that help clients escape poverty and achieve full employment, prevent abuse and neglect among children and vulnerable adults, strengthen families and promotes positive youth development, provide public health insurance for low-income adults and children, and empower people with disabilities so they can enter or re-enter the workforce.

- Social Services Division (SSD)
- Med-QUEST Division (MQD)
- Division of Vocational Rehabilitation (DVR)

The DHS also oversees four administratively-attached agencies and commissions:

- Hawaii Public Housing Authority (HPHA)
- Office of Youth Services (OYS)
- Hawaii State Commission on the Status of Women (HSCSW) and
- State Commission on Fatherhood (COF)
