Re: Annual Report for programs funded under Act 281, Session Laws of Hawaii (SLH) 2006, Non-school Hour Programs

BACKGROUND

The 2006 Hawaii State Legislature appropriated state general funds through Act 281 (SLH 2006) for the Office of Youth Services (OYS), Department of Education (DOE), and the four counties' Departments of Parks and Recreation (DPR) to establish programs services and activities to provide safe, structured learning environments for children and youth during non-school hours. As a result of Act 281 (SLH 2006) funding, DOE, OYS, and DPR implemented non-school hour programs and services serving children and youth state-wide during FY 2007 and 2008.

To continue the intent of Act 281 (SLH 2006), the 2008 Hawaii State Legislature stipulated that Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) federal block grant funds appropriated to DHS be expended for non-school hours programs and services to address TANF Purpose Area 3: To prevent and reduce out-of-wedlock pregnancies. In FY 2009, OYS issued an RFP for TANF Teen Pregnancy Prevention Through Non-School Hours Positive Youth Development Programs; services procured through the RFP were provided for youth in FY 2009.

ANNUAL REPORT

There is no report for FY2016 as funding for non-school hour programs have not been appropriated since 2008.
