I. Call to Order

Present is Commissioners Alan Sunio, Kawika Riley, Kawika Mattos, Dan, Kittredge, Caleb Milliken, and Richard Kebo called to order at 2:53 pm.

II. Public Testimony

III. <u>Approval of Minutes</u>

Commissioners moved to strike the 50/50 in "custody bill".

IV. Discussion

a. Selection of new Chair and Vice Chair

Commissioner Kittredge is seeking clarity about the June decision. Concerns about having a neighbor island Chair. Also concerns about Oahu Commissioners Riley and Kebo terms expiring at the end of June and not having Oahu representation. Because the Commission is Oahu centric it is important to have a Commissioner serve as Chair or Vice Chair to facilitate administrative duties. At this time there does not seem to be much interest in a Commissioner taking over as Chair, and minimal interest as Vice Chair.

Commissioner Riley suggests setting aside additional funds to cover travel and administrative costs that may be associated with having a neighbor island Chair, and Vice Chair.

Hawaii Rise Foundation is the only organization to not receiving funds due to its lack of application strength. The motion is moved by Commissioner Kittridge and second by Commissioner Riley.
