### Hawaii County Co-Branding Options:

- The 'ōhia lehua is the flower that represents the island of Hawaii.



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## Honolulu County Co-Branding Options:

- The island's color is yellow, and its flower is the pua from the 'ilima (Sida fallax), an herbaceous plant in the Hibiscus family.



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## Kauai County Co-Branding Options:

- The island's color is a regal purple and its flowers come from the endemic mokihana tree (pelea anisata).



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## Maui County Co-Branding Options:

- The color of the Valley Isle is pink from the petals of the island's flora emblem, the Lokelani rose.
